1) Code Review:

The Board completed its review of a proposed Special Event Code. The Town Clerk will make the changes and distribute the revised code to the Board. They also discussed the solar power moratorium.

2) Jackson Falls/Major Park proposal:

The Board and Town Attorney discussed the implications created by using Majors Park as a “match” for a grant for the WNY Land Conservancy to purchase the Jackson Falls (aka: Mothers Falls) property. Attorney Bennett stated that this involves a deed, not an easement. Supervisor Bach stated he did not recall any restrictions as to the use or development of Majors Park being mentioned in prior conversations.
