

New York State enacted the Town Historian Law on April 11, 1919. B. Frank Dake, a lawyer with an interest in local history, was appointed the following autumn, but his successor was not appointed until the office was re-established in 1950.

* The Village of East Aurora established the office of Village Historian on January 3, 1950. The Town Board established the office of Town Historian on January 23, 1950.

+ Calling the task "too great for one person to undertake," Persons resigned as Town Historian in 1952, but his resignation wasn't acted upon until his successor was appointed in 1957.



^ Virginia Vidler died in office. The office of the Historian was vacant from her death until February 28, 1987.
