A LOCAL LAW, TO AMEND LOCAL LAW 1-1990 KNOWN AS "THE CODES OF THE TOWN OF AURORA", ADOPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AURORA ON JANUARY 22, 1990, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 113 REGARDING \_\_\_\_\_.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AURORA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Local Law amends a prior Local Law known as "The Town of Aurora Code" adopted by the Town of Aurora on January 22, 1990, as amended, relating to the administrative, legislative and general legislation of Codes within the Town of Aurora as therein set forth..

SECTION 2. SECTION 113-34, BILLING PROCEDURE; PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENTS

Section ~~113~~ 34 is amended to read as follows:

Checks for payments of water district bills and water charges shall be made payable to the water district. Meters will be read and bills rendered at regular quarterly intervals. Bills for the previous quarter shall be due and payable at the office and on the date designated on the bill. Unpaid water charges,

including charges to out-of-district users, in arrears for 30 days or longer shall be subject to a penalty not exceeding 10% of the amount due, and the Water Department and/or Erie County Water Authority may cut off the supply of water if such water charges are not paid within 60 days of the date due. The Town Board may, by rules and regulations, provide for an additional charge for restoring the service of water in addition to the unpaid water bill.

### SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Local Law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the New York Secretary of State.

A LOCAL LAW, TO AMEND LOCAL LAW 1-1990 KNOWN AS “THE CODES OF THE TOWN OF AURORA”, ADOPTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AURORA ON JANUARY 22, 1990, BY AMENDING THE ZONE MAP.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE TOWN BOARD OF THE TOWN OF AURORA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT

This Local Law amends a prior Local Law known as “The Town of Aurora Code” adopted by the Town of Aurora on January 22, 1990, as amended, relating to the administrative, legislative and general legislation of Codes within the Town of Aurora as therein set forth. This Local Law will amend the boundaries of the Zone Map to transfer the described property from its present location in a an A and B1 Zoning District to a B2 Zoning District.

SECTION 2. SECTION 116-6, ZONE MAP

Section 116-6(A), Zone Map, of the of the Codes of the Town of Aurora is amended as follows:

The present Zone Map adopted heretofore describing the district boundaries within the Town of Aurora is amended to transfer and place the following described property from its present classification as an A and B1 Zoning District to a B2 Zoning District:

Parcel "A"

ALL THAT TRACT OR PARCEL OF LAND, situate in the Town of Aurora, County of Erie and State of New York, being part of Lot No. 13, Township 9, Range 6 of the Holland Land Company's Survey bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the center line of Olean Road 951.52 feet northwesterly from the intersection of the center line of Olean Road and the south line of said Lot Number 13 as measured along the center line of Olean Road, said point being the northwest corner of lands conveyed to Edward W. Osgood by deed recorded in Erie County Clerk's Office in Liber 3285 of Deeds at page 100; thence east parallel with the south line of said Lot Number 13, 402.90 feet to a point; thence southwesterly and making a westerly and included angle of 33E 19' a distance of 324.76 feet to a point in the center line of Olean Road 221.62 feet southeasterly of the place of beginning; thence northwesterly along the center line of Olean Road 221.62 feet to the point or place of beginning.

Gerstung and his wife by deed recorded in Erie County Clerk's Office in Liber 7221 of Deeds at page 170; thence northwesterly along the easterly line of lands conveyed to Gerstung as aforesaid and extension thereof 305.14 feet to a point; thence northerly making an interior angle of 164E 28' to the last mentioned

lin 126.94 feet to the south line of lands conveyed to Ralph A. 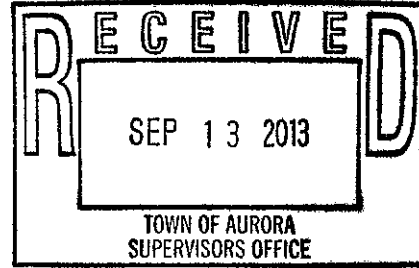

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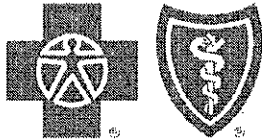

Thank you everyone for your assistance with the budget. I am pleased with the outcome for all of the residents. There are a few actions that need to be taken.

1. Below is a summation of the changes to the Tentative Budget made during the October 2, 2013 Special Town Board Budget Work Session that the Town Board needs to approve.
  - Change A 6772.114 – Part-time Recreation Personnel from \$0 to \$5535
  - Change A 7020.110 – Recreation Supervisor from \$33,596 to \$28,061
  - Change A 1081 – Payments in Lieu of Taxes from \$6193 to \$6236

I have also added the following as the information came into my office:

- Added Delinquent Water to Levy (ECWA) - \$917.85
2. The Town Board must accept the amended 2014 Tentative Budget as the 2014 Preliminary budget.
  3. The Preliminary Budget Presentation and Public Hearing will be scheduled for Work Session on October 22<sup>nd</sup> so the entire Town Board can be present.
