





- We have 14,559 members registered in our recreation system
- We had 58 individual program registrations in the month of February
- We generated \$2,472 in sales for February
- Credit card purchases totaled 80% (83% on-line, 17% office)

 - Total sales from 1/1/2021 – 2/28/2021 \$3,966

This was the most normal Winterfest we have had in over a year. We were able to be able to run our art programs of Cartooning and Photography Camp. Our Chili contest had the most attendants we've had in years, if not of all time! Congratulations to The Deli for coming in first with Elm Street Bakery coming in a close second.

Summer program planning continues. With the pandemic slowing down, we are confident we will be able to host all of our programs. Our current struggle is getting enough staff to run them. Summer program planning has come to an end. We posted all of our programs on the our website, sent digital fliers to the school, and advertised on our Facebook page.
