UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

The Board discussed a letter from Peter Sorgi, attorney for Donald Pressing, that outlined and confirmed the direction that the Town Board gave at the August 19, 2014 work session regarding a revised site plan for Mr. Pressing's property.

The Board reviewed Part 2 – Impact Assessment of the Short Environmental Assessment form for the proposed Emery Road Open Development Area.

Councilwoman Jeffe moved that the proposed two-lot Open Development Area at SBL#187.00-4-52.12 Emery Road in the Town of Aurora will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts. Councilman Snyder seconded the motion. Upon a vote being taken: ayes – five noes – none Motion carried. Action #260 Negative declaration for SEQR determined for Emery Road ODA

Councilman Snyder moved to adopt the following resolution; seconded by Councilman Harris:

RESOLUTION APPROVING OPEN DEVELOPMENT AREA PLAN TO SPLIT SBL# 187.00-4-52.12 EMERY ROAD, TOWN OF AURORA, NEW YORK

WHEREAS, Chapter 79 of the Code of the Town of Aurora establishes standards for landowners who wish to develop or subdivide land that lacks required public road frontage for standard lot development (known as "open development area"); and

WHEREAS, the Applicant, Andrew Romanowski - ARR Holdings, LLC, has filed an Open Development Area application to subdivide SBL# 187.00-4-52.12 located along the north side of Emery Road, west of Center Street, into two parcels both lacking required public road frontage – parcel one being 5.08 acres with 60 feet of frontage and parcel two being 6.15 acres with 74 feet of frontage; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board has reviewed the SEQRA Short Environmental Assessment Form, submitted as part of the application, determining that the proposed use will not have a significant impact on the environment, and

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WHEREAS, the Applicant has made every reasonable attempt and all necessary effort to comply with specifications of Chapter 79 of the Code of the Town of Aurora; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the Town Board of the Town of Aurora approves the Open Area Development application to split SBL# 187.00-4-52.12, located along the north side of Emery Road, west of Center Street, into two parcels, each lacking required public road frontage with the following conditions: (1) each proposed residential home shall be equipped with a sprinkler system designed with Building Department approval; (2) each lot shall have its own driveway; and (3) vehicle access will be in accordance with NYS Fire Code, appendix D, and be it further

RESOLVED, that in the event one driveway is to be constructed to access both parcels, an Easement and Maintenance Agreement approved by the property owners using the private drive shall be submitted to the Town of Aurora for review by the Town Attorney; and be it further

RESOLVED, that approval by the Town Board of the Town of Aurora is expressly for the split of SBL#187.00-4-52.12 located along the north side of Emery Road, west of Center Street, into two parcels both lacking required public road frontage – parcel one being 5.08 acres with 60 feet of frontage and parcel two being 6.15 acres with 74 feet of frontage; and be it further

RESOLVED, that said Open Development Area Plan for the split of SBL# 187.00-4-52.12 Emery Road into two parcels is approved.

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STAFF REPORTS:

Peggy Cooke spoke about Hamlin Park noting that the Village of East Aurora owns the park and is responsible for capital improvements, while the Town maintains the park. Mrs. Cooke stated that the issue at hand is the condition of the tennis courts which are in bad shape and have been for a number of years. She noted that the Village is looking to apply for a grant for Hamlin Park and that a new tennis court would probably cost about \$120,000. Mrs. Cooke thanked: 1) Art Aungst for stepping-up to the EAST coaching position for a few months; 2) Kiwanis and Chuck Snyder for moving and renovating the baseball concession stand.
