Councilwoman Jeffe moved to adopt the following resolution; seconded by Councilwoman Friess:

### RESOLUTION APPROVING OPEN DEVELOPMENT AREA PLAN 4485 TRANSIT ROAD SBL#174.00-1-42 TOWN OF AURORA, NEW YORK

**WHEREAS,** Chapter 79 of the Code of The Town of Aurora establishes standards for landowners who wish to develop or subdivide land that lacks required public road frontage for standard lot development (known as "open development area"); and

**WHEREAS,** the Applicant, David Schwing, has filed a single-lot Open Development Area application for 4485 Transit Road (SBL# 174.00-1-42), located along the east side of Transit Road between Jewett Holmwood Road and Route 20A, which lacks required public road frontage; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aurora Town Board granted out-of-district water customer status to the Applicant to become a water customer to the Town of Orchard Park for this parcel; and

**WHEREAS**, the Zoning Board of Appeals of the Town of Aurora granted a width variance of twenty feet to allow a portion of the ingress/egress to be thirty feet wide rather than required fifty feet; and

**WHEREAS**, the Aurora Planning Board reviewed this ODA application and recommended that it be approved with the addition of a vehicle pull-off near the driveway entrance to the parcel; and

**WHEREAS,** the Town Board has reviewed the SEQRA Short Environmental Assessment Form, submitted as part of the application, determining that the proposed use (single family residence) will not have a significant impact on the environment, and

**WHEREAS**, the Applicant has made every reasonable attempt and all necessary effort to comply with specifications of Chapter 79 of the Code of the Town of Aurora; and

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board of the Town of Aurora approves the Open Area Development application for 4485 Transit Road (SBL# 174.00-1-42), located along the east side of Transit Road, between Jewett Holmwood Road and Route 20A, which lacks required public road frontage with the following conditions: (1) the proposed residential home shall be equipped with a sprinkler system, designed with Building Department approval; (2) vehicle access will be in accordance with NYS Fire Code, appendix D; and (3) a vehicle pull-off be constructed on the property near the driveway entrance; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that approval by the Town Board of the Town of Aurora is expressly for 4485 Transit Road (SBL#174.00-1-42) located along the east side of Transit Road, between Jewett Holmwood Road and Route 20A; and be it further Action #278 4485 Transit Rd ODA approved with conditions.

**RESOLVED**, that said Open Development Area Plan for the 4485 Transit Road (SBL# 174.00-1-42) is approved.

Donald Pressing Jr. and his attorney, Peter Sorgi, presented a revised site plan for 992 Olean Road prior to tonight's meeting, along with a letter dated 9/3/14 noting the following: 1) Entrance way widened to 20 feet;

2) Location of proposed 50' by 64' building unchanged;

3) All surface water from proposed building will be directed to the drainage ditch to the north;4) Lights will be properly shielded;

5) The large piece of equipment/machinery known as "Big Red" will be stored in the new building, or if it cannot be, then a carport/lean-to will be constructed as shown on the amended site plan;

6) Mr. Pressing intends to commence construction, depending on weather, after all governmental approvals are attained.

In his letter, Mr. Sorgi referred to a revised SEQR EAF. Supervisor Bach noted that a negative declaration was given by the Town Board on this matter at their July 14, 2014 meeting.

Supervisor Bach asked Mr. Pressing when he plans to start construction on the building. Mr. Pressing responded he plans to start this fall and finish by June 2015.

Councilwoman Jeffe asked Mr. Pressing if he would be able to get the dealership for equipment. Mr. Pressing responded that he will have the dealership before the building is done.

Councilwoman Jeffe moved to approve the Site Plan (drawn by Nussbaumer & Clarke, Inc., dated 3/14/14 and revised 8/26/14) for 992 Olean Road (SBL#188.01-2-11.11) with the conditions noted in the letter dated 9/3/14 from Hopkins & Sorgi, PLLC on behalf of Donald Pressing. Councilwoman Friess seconded the motion. Upon a vote being taken: ayes – three noes – none Motion carried. Action #279 992 Olean site plan approved with conditions.

### NEW BUSINESS:

Jewett Holmwood LLC, (JH,LLC) owner and project sponsor of the Reed Hill Heights Subdivision, is looking to improve the aesthetics of the westerly cul-de-sac on Creekview Court where the sewer pump station and generator are located. They are proposing that the existing six feet high fence be securely placed on top of a four feet high (at its highest point) stone wall. JH, LLC has already presented the plan to the Erie County Department of Environment and Planning (ECDEP). The ECDEP is requesting a resolution stating that the Town does not object to the proposal. Highway Superintendent Gunner raised the question of who will be maintaining the wall and fence. Peter Sorgi, attorney for JH,LLC, stated he will be contacting the ECDEP to see if they would maintain the wall and fence.

Councilwoman Friess moved to adopt the following resolution contingent upon the Town not having to maintain the wall and fence surrounding the sewer pump station and generator located in the westerly cul-de-sac on Creekview Court; seconded by Councilwoman Jeffe:

The Aurora Town Board does not object to Jewett Holmwood LLC's request to the Erie County Department of Environment and Planning to allow the raising of the existing six feet tall fence around the sewer pump station and generator at the western cul-de-sac on Creekview Court by securely placing the fence upon a four feet high stone wall. Upon a vote being taken: ayes – three noes – none Motion carried.
