Section 116.8.1E(2)

Required: Where 20% or more of the lots in the same block on the same side of the street and within 1,000 feet of a proposed building are improved with buildings, the average setback of such existing buildings shall establish the minimum setback or building line. This provision shall not be interpreted to permit a front yard depth of less than 45 feet.




