I purchased the property located at 1000 Quaker Rd over 8 years ago and we have thoroughly enjoyed our primary residential home.

We are seeking to update and improve the current fence that has existed on the site for 30-plus years. This would greatly enhance our new neighbors' enjoyment as well as maintain an additional level of privacy and security for our current pool/patio. In conversation with our new neighbor, Julie (and really the only neighbor that has a view of the fence), she approves of the replacement fence as well. 
