General Information

- 1. Hired Brendan O'Hara as a police officer on October 20, 2015. Brendan is in our Field Training and Evaluation Program working with several of our Officers and should complete the program around the middle of November.
- 2. I applied for a week of training sponsored by Department of Criminal Justice Services and put on by the International Associations of Chiefs of Police, titled 'Leadership in Police Organizations Program'. The training is being held in Saratoga Springs and is limited to 36 seats and DCJS will be selecting applicants from around the state. Training and lodging is free to attendees. I should know in the beginning of November if I have been selected. On 11/5/15 I received confirmation that I was one of 36 Chiefs of Police selected to attend the week training.
- 3. The Department hosted a Flu Shot clinic.
- 4. Meetings Attended:

 - Met with Special Agent in Charge Todd Laster, United States Secret Service

Arrests / Investigations

 On October 6 the Department received a 911 call regarding a burglary in progress at the Kelly Dr. apartments. A female arrived home to find a male in her apartment, who upon seeing her, ran out through a shattered sliding glass door. A couple hours later the Department arrested the Subject, who lived in the same building and is under investigation

for another burglary in town. The Subject is currently residing at the Erie County Holding Center.

- The Moose Lodge reported several thousands of dollars missing. After a thorough
 investigation Det. Longboat was able to interview the recently resigned administrator of the
 Lodge and was able to obtain a confession. The administrator admitted stealing \$10,000
 from the Lodge over several months.
- 3. On October 24th Larwood's Pharmacy was robbed at gun point by two Subjects. The Subject's were there to steal narcotic opiates and specifically instructed the Pharmacist to give them just that. Although the Robbers were physical with the Victims in the store, no one was physically hurt during the crime. Even with both Subjects having their faces covered, good evidence was recovered from the scene and we have received several tips from the public regarding the possible identities of the Subjects after their pictures from Larwood's surveillance video were shown by the media. ** At the time of this report Det. Longboat is following leads regarding the subjects involved in the robbery and I will report any updates when available**
- 4. On October 29th at 7:18 pm we received a call for help from a family on Sweet Rd. that their 82 year old mother went for a walk in the woods and failed to return home, with the family scared that their mother was in danger. Lt. Welch and patrols responded and due to the vast wooded area needed to be searched, requested assistance from East Aurora, West Falls and Marilia Fire Departments. At 9:30 pm the Victim was located and extracted from the woods uninjured but extremely cold. The Victim had been out in the 39th rainy weather for 5 ½ hours, only dressed for a short walk.
