As we discussed this morning (2-12-25), the farmer is approved to begin restoring the quality of hay within the designated hay field at Mill Road Scenic Overlook. As agreed, this restoration will take place in quarter increments, meaning one-quarter of the field will be treated each year.

This approval is contingent on the hay species being either orchard grass (*Dactylis glomerata L.*) or timothy (*Phleum pratense*).

For 2024, the Erie County Water Authority (ECWA) has increased the infrastructure, minimum usage and per 1,000-gallon usage water rates for commodity users. Commodity users are those water lines served from a master meter. The Town of Aurora is obligated to pass these increases on to the consumer/water customer.

Based on 2023 expenses incurred by the Town for a water director, water testing, and electric fees, the Operations and Administration (O&A) fee that you are billed quarterly will increase by \$0.01. The Repair and Maintenance (R&M) fee will remain at \$25.00.
