General Information

- A full-time dispatcher was on sick leave for several weeks including all of February due to having surgery. Most of the shifts were filled by part-time dispatchers.
- EAPD's budget was completed and submitted for 2018-19.
- Officer Kawalerski's field training program is progressing well.
- With the upcoming Raise the Age law beginning in October 2018, the department will need more space to comply with state law when dealing/detaining individuals 16 and under this year and both 16 and 17 year old youths next October. 16 and 17 year olds currently can be held as adults when arrested or interviewed, the new law will treat them as juveniles, who cannot be held where adults are held.
