Deer Population is Out of Control By: Lyn Chimera, EAGC Member

East Aurora is being overrun by deer! They are everywhere and not at all afraid of humans. They are bold enough to show themselves even during the daylight hours.

At a recent EA Garden Club meeting people were discussing how deer were much worse this summer and eating things they have never touched before. They have also noticed the does this season all have twins. This will increase the deer population even more. Just imagine what life will be like with 3 times as many deer and no predators to control the population.

Why is this a problem? It's not just the garden plants they are devouring but other factors. Nationwide deer damage costs \$2 BILLION!! One billion of this is from vehicle accidents, \$100 million in crop damage, \$750 million in damage to the timber industry and last on the list is \$250 in landscape damage. Unfortunately, those aren't the only concerns.

White tailed deer are the primary host for deer ticks which carry Lyme disease. Ticks need deer to lay their eggs and have a blood meal. Ticks need a blood meal in each of the 4 stages of their 2-year development. While deer are a common host meal and carry the ticks, they do not get Lyme disease. After the tick has gotten a blood meal from the deer it drops off and awaits its next meal which includes humans. The ticks are being spread from forest edges to our backyards by deer.

A community in Connecticut reduced their deer population to 5.1 per square kilometer (that's only .36 square miles) which decreased reports of Lyme disease by 80%! Of course, this reduction also was evident in fewer vehicle accidents and much less landscape damage. I have had 2 ticks on me from my yard this season. Luckily, I discovered them before being bitten.

Yes, deer are beautiful animals with big brown eyes and were here first. However, there are more deer per acre now than before the Europeans came. Much of this is due to people creating a habitat where they can thrive. It's time we took the increasing deer problem seriously and take action. Many communities have used a variety of methods to decrease the deer population from culling to sterilization. East Aurora needs to take a serious look at some of the solutions for the well-being of ourselves AND our landscapes.
